

Literacy/ Numeracy Catch Up Funding 2017/18

Proposed use of Funding

The Department for Education (DfE) provided additional funding for all students in Year 7 from 2012 onwards, who achieved below their age related expectations at the end of KS2. This additional funding is to be used by schools to provide literacy and numeracy catch-up support for Year 7 students. It is designed to help students catch up as quickly as possible.

| <p><i>A large proportion of the Literacy and Numeracy funding will be allocated to improving the Literacy and Numeracy resources for pupils to access during tutor times as well as specific ICT packages to support Literacy and Numeracy in the curriculum. Funding will also be used to pay for specific members of staff to co-ordinate these areas.</i></p> <p><i>A small proportion of this funding will be allocated to staffing to provide additional tutor based support for students in Year 7.</i></p> |
