

#### This is the exam Criteria

#### Entry 2 - 2 pieces one on a tuned instrument

- 8 bars 16 bars long;
- Up to 5 different notes;
- contain simple rhythms mainly semibreves, minims and/or crotchets if a melodic piece;
- contain rhythms -dotted & quaver rhythms if on an untuned instrument

#### Entry 3 - 2 pieces one on a tuned instrument

- Be a minimum of 16 bars and maximum of 32 bars long;
- Have a range of at least 5 different notes;
- Contain quavers and/or dotted notes in the rhythm.

If you have chosen music but not been recorded yet, please practise!

If you have been recorded, keep up your skills by learning music that is attached!

Sing or play short, simple pieces as part of an ensemble.


