- 20: Twentieth square from left, 12 squares across.

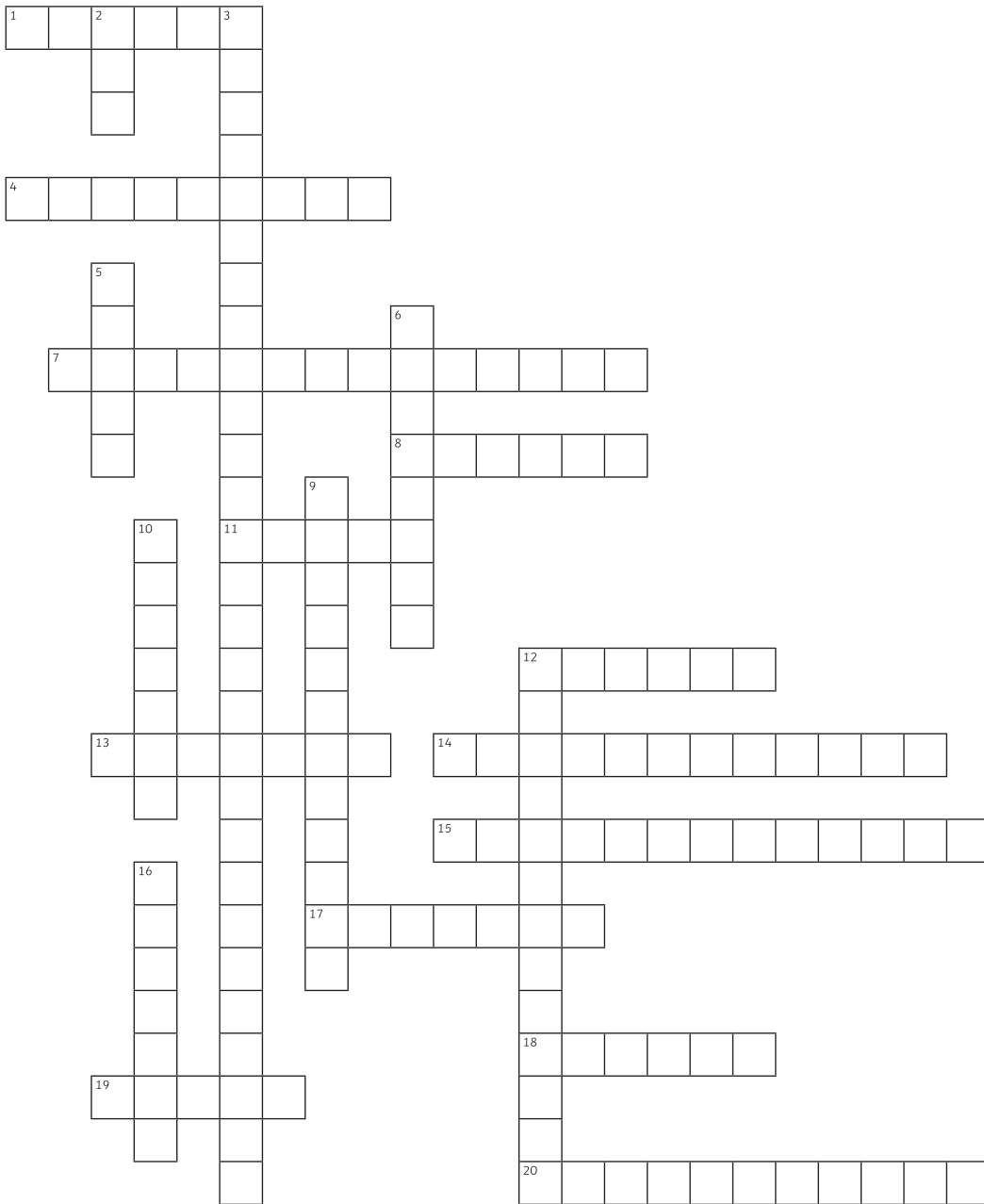

7. 28-day cycle of events that occurs in the female body, which starts during adolescence. [9,5]
8. Ring of muscle at the top of the vagina. [6]
11. Liquid mixed with sperm. [5]
12. Covering for the penis to protect against disease and reduce the chance of pregnancy. [6]
13. Physical changes that happen to the human body during adolescence. [7]
14. Shedding of the lining of the uterus. [12]
15. Fusion of gametes. [13]
17. Tube that connects the ovaries and the uterus. [7]
18. Where male sex cells are produced. [6]
