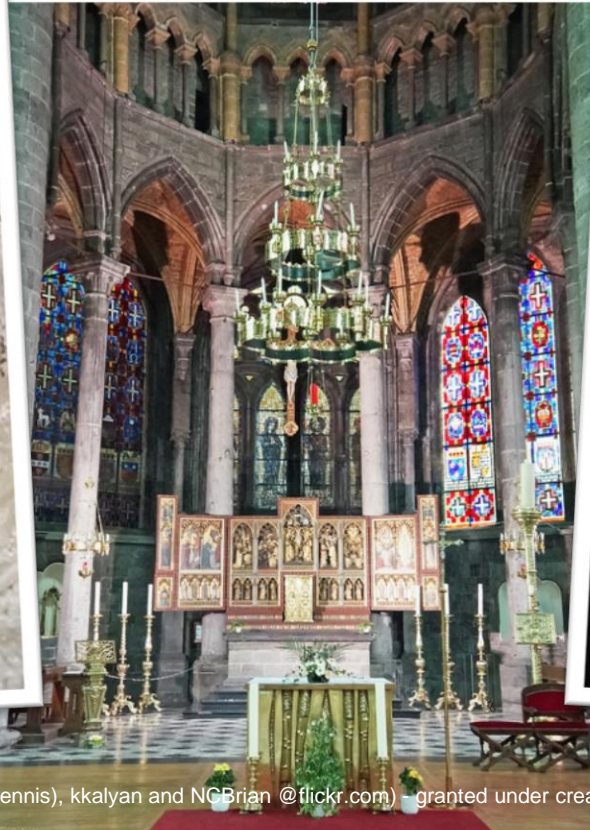
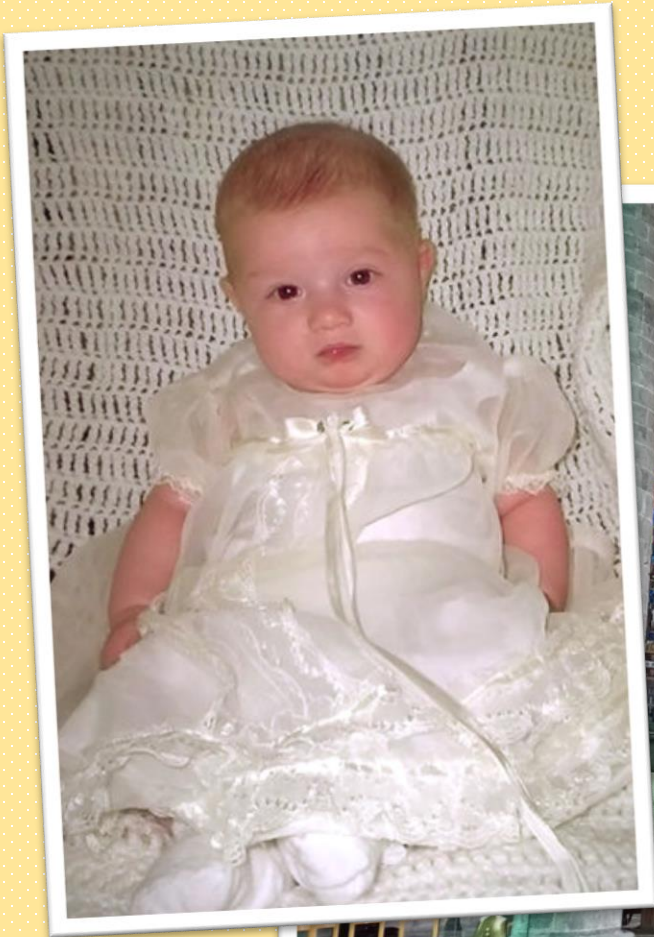

# Success Criteria

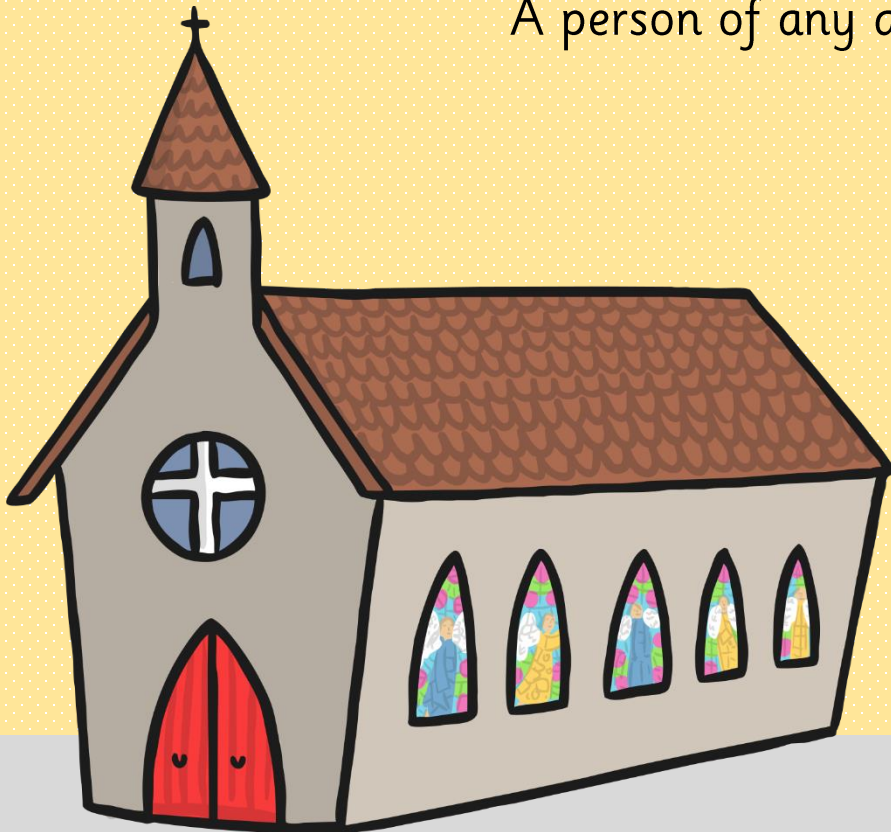
- I can explain who can be baptised.

# What is a Baptism??

This is a special service in church when the family and priest thank God for a new baby. The priest welcomes the baby into God's family.

A person of any age can be baptised.

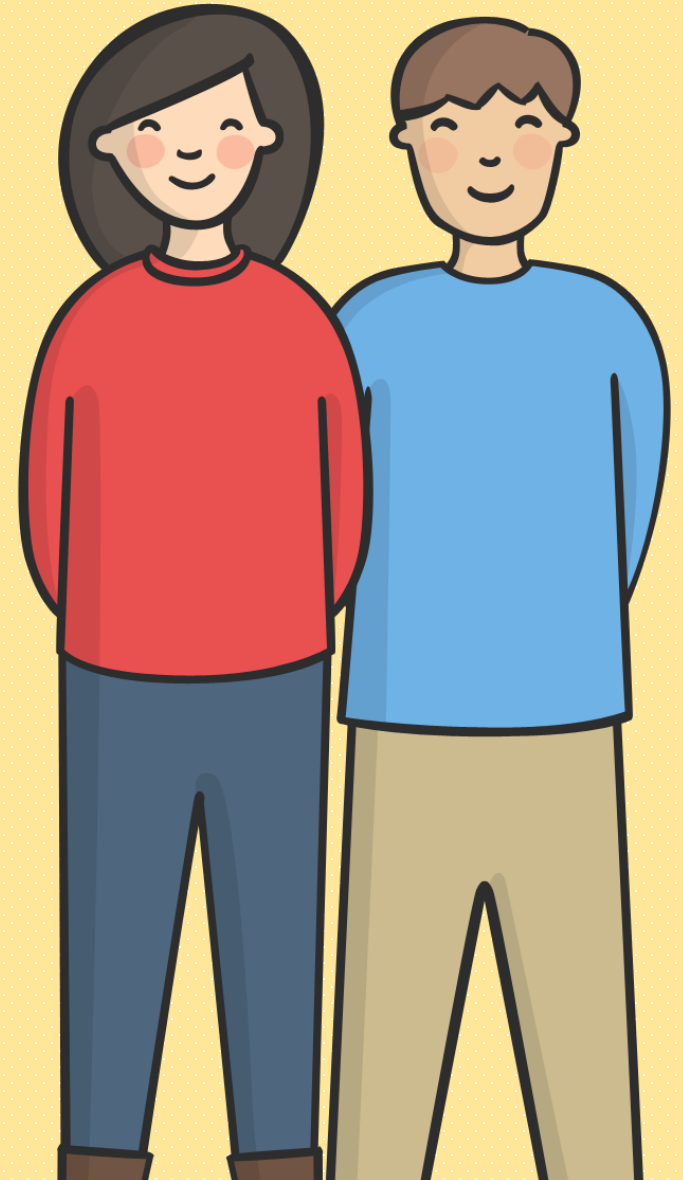


# Special People

God parents are an important part of the baptism service.

Before the baptism, the parents of the baby choose godparents to help them to look after their child.

Along with the parents of the baby at the baptism, the godparents say they believe in God then make special promises to look after the child and help him or her to grow up to be a good Christian person.

The baby will wear a special outfit because a baptism is a very special occasion in their life.

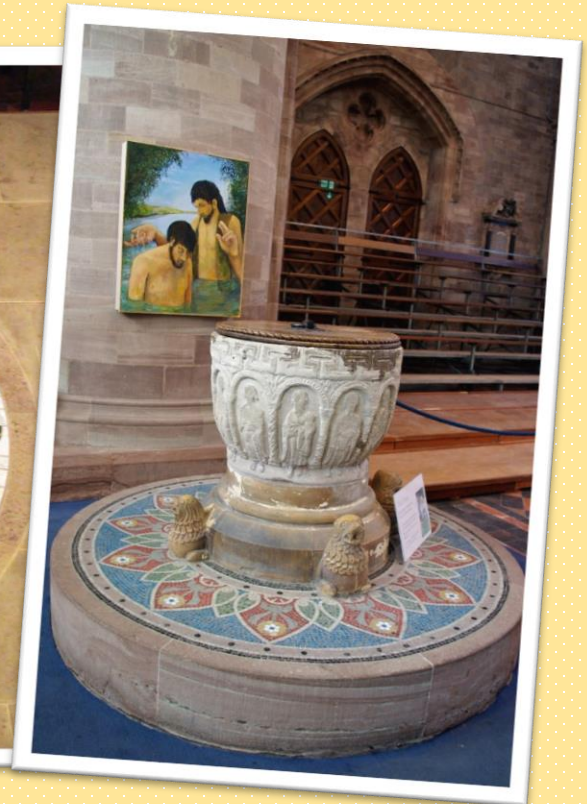
# Special Objects

The vicar pours water into the font then blesses it. The baby has some of this special water poured over their head to show that the baby is clean, pure and a new member of God's family.

The vicar says important words as the water is poured over the baby's head. 'I baptise you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen'
