Literacy/ Numeracy Catch Up Funding 2019/20 Proposed use of Funding

The Department for Education (DfE) provided additional funding for all students in Year 7 from 2012 onwards, who achieved below their age related expectations at the end of KS2. This additional funding is to be used by schools to provide literacy and numeracy catchup support for Year 7 students. It is designed to help students catch up as quickly as possible.

Nature of support proposed 2019/20

A large proportion of the Literacy and Numeracy funding will be allocated to improving the Literacy and Numeracy resources for pupils to access during tutor times as well as specific ICT packages to support Literacy, Communication and Numeracy in the curriculum.

A small proportion of this funding will be allocated to staffing to provide additional tutor based support for students in Year 7.
