YAS stands for
Youth Award Scheme



In YAS you will follow one of three courses. The course you follow depends on the level you are working at.

- ASDAN Bronze, Silver or Gold suits learners who are able to work independently, have good ICT and literacy skills.
- ASDAN Towards Independence suits learners who are able to work as part of a team and can complete some work independently.
- ASDAN Transition Challenge suits learners who need extra support with their work.



What do we do in YAS?

In all of the courses you will complete challenges that will help you develop your independent skills and life skills, helping you prepare for the wider world. Some of the activities include:

- Cooking a basic meal
- Making a hot drink
- Reading a bus timetable
- Cleaning and tidying a room
- Researching a topic
- Presenting to your class
