

Teaching of Phonics

Where appropriate, pupils are assessed for their phonics knowledge and skills at the beginning of each academic year. Pupils are taught as groups/individually in accordance with their needs, using the systematic synthetic phonics teaching programme by Twinkl as well as other strategies to support reading.

Staff are provided with regular training to ensure that all pupils, regardless of their age, have access to good quality phonics teaching when needed.
