Nature of support proposed 2024/25

A large proportion of the PE and sports funding money will be allocated to staffing costs and the employment of additional PE specialist to work in the Primary Department. This will ensure that pupils retain a high level of specialist staff to enable the PE curriculum and delivery to be appropriate to the wide range of needs in the school. This funding also supports the role of a school games co-ordinator and Forest Schools which is run by external coaches.

Support and funding will also be allocated to those pupils eligible for additional specialist teachers, extra-curricular activities, enrichment opportunities and specialised equipment and materials.

Below is a breakdown of some of the areas of support targeted for this year.

- KS1 & 2 curriculum teaching
- Increased staff : pupil ratio when/ where needed
- All pupils to access Forest Schools
- Extra-Curricular activities
- Access to specialist equipment and facilities
- External coaches to support curriculum
- Increased opportunities for inter-school sports

Proposed Outcomes for PE and Sports Funding spending 2024/25

Pupils have full access to PE specialists to deliver their curriculum through investment in additional PE specialist staff ensuring staff:pupil ratio is high, adapted materials or equipment are available as are additional enrichment and additional opportunities.

100% of pupil access swimming as part of their curriculum and weekly after- school swimming club is available for pupils to access.
