



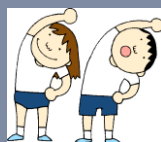

Key Stage 4 Pathways Curriculum Information



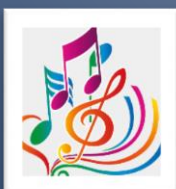
Your child will be moving into year 10 – Key stage 4 in September 2025.

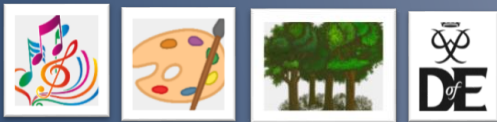
KEY STAGE 4 CURRICULUM

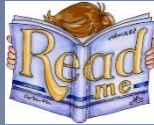

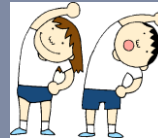
MAINTAINING THE CORE CURRICULUM

- **Forest school**

Pupils will select one subject from A, B and C (Student preference will be taken into account when allocating subjects but 1st Choices may not always be possible)



HOW DOES THIS BENEFIT THE PUPILS ?



- Pupils can make their preferences to suit their skills and interests.
- Accreditation is adaptable to meet the individual needs of pupils.
- Pathway subjects link to Post 16 college courses.
- Focused college transition programme in Year 11 – Summer term
- Opportunities to participate in community work experience placements in July of year 11 - Individual or as a supervised group.
